

The Flyover Show - South Africa 31 March 2012

UK hip-hop and jazz guru Soweto Kinch hosts a groundbreaking show featuring a diverse and brilliant line-up in Freedom Square, South Africa on **31 March 2012** from **10am - 6pm**.

Confirmed artists are **Tumi** from Tumi and the Volume, **Soweto Kinch** and band, **Feya Faku**, **ESKA**, **Jonzi D**, **Bokani Dyer**, **DJ Raiko** and the **Kliptown Youth Program Gumboot Dancers**.

This year Kinch, one of the most exciting and versatile young musicians in both the British jazz and hip-hop scenes, brings his iconic festival from the streets of Birmingham to the streets of the South African township with which he shares his name - Soweto.

The show will take place in the historic Freedom Square – also known as the Walter Sisulu Square of dedication – in Kliptown.

The Flyover Show is Kinch's flagship project; a day-long, music and arts festival which, for the last five years, has taken place beneath a motorway flyover in Birmingham, UK.

Soweto Kinch comments: "*Freedom Square is in many ways the most natural place to extend the concept of The Flyover Show abroad. I have both a deep artistic and personal connection to Johannesburg and I'm really excited about expanding this concept there. As an area with rich often unappreciated traditions it has much similarity with the areas in Birmingham where the show was originated.*"

The Birmingham leg of the festival features artists as diverse as **Goldie**, **Ms Dynamite** and **Omar** and continues to build on its reputation, bringing world-class entertainment to an often neglected corner of inner-city Birmingham.
